

# **Active Sports Essex Safeguarding Policy Statement**

Active Sports Essex acknowledges the duty of care to safeguard and promote the welfare of children, Young People and adults at risk. The organisation is committed to ensuring safeguarding practice reflects statutory responsibilities, government guidance and complies with best practice and requirements. A copy of the organisation full safeguarding policy is available the Active Sports Essex website.

The organisation safeguarding policy recognises that the welfare and interests of children, Young People and adults at risk are paramount in all circumstances. It aims to ensure that regardless of age, ability or disability, gender reassignment, race, religion or belief, sex or sexual orientation, socio-economic background, all children:

- have a positive and enjoyable experience with Active Sports Essex in a safe and inclusive environment
- are protected from abuse whilst participating in Sport.

Active Sports Essex acknowledges that some children, including disabled children and young people or those from ethnic minority communities, can be particularly vulnerable to abuse and we accept the responsibility to take reasonable and appropriate steps to ensure their welfare.

As part of our safeguarding policy Active Sports Essex will:

- promote and prioritise the safety and well-being of children and adults at risk
- ensure everyone understands their roles and responsibilities in respect of safeguarding and is provided with appropriate learning opportunities to recognise, identify and respond to signs of abuse, neglect and other safeguarding concerns relating to children and adults at risk
- encourage and maintain a culture where people feel able to raise a genuine safeguarding concern and are confident that it will be taken seriously
- ensure appropriate action is taken in the event of incidents/concerns of abuse and support provided to the individual/s who raise or disclose the concern
- ensure that confidential, detailed and accurate records of all safeguarding concerns are maintained and securely stored
- prevent the employment/deployment of unsuitable individuals
- ensure robust safeguarding arrangements and procedures are in operation

The organisation policy and procedures will be widely promoted and are mandatory for everyone involved in Active Sports Essex. Failure to comply with the policy and procedures will be addressed and may result in dismissal/exclusion from the Organisation.
